Right to Request Teacher Qualification

The Philipsburg-Osceola School district receives federal funds for Title I that are part of the *Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) of 2015*.

As parent/guardian, you have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s). If you request this information, the school district will provide you with the following information as soon as possible:

- If the teacher has met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subjects in which the teacher is providing instruction;
- If the teacher is teaching under emergency status for which the state licensing requirements have been waived;
- The type of college degree major of the teachers and the field of discipline for any graduate degree or certificate; and/or
- If your child is receiving Title I services from a paraprofessional and, if so, his/her qualifications.
