

# PHILIPSBURG-OSCEOLA AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT COVID-19 CASE RESPONSE

## IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Immediate isolation for a minimum of 5 days following onset of symptoms (day 0) or positive test results.

May return to school on day 6 if symptoms are improving and fever free (**without fever reducing medication**) for at least 24 hours prior to release from isolation.

AND

Wear a mask at school for an additional 5 days.

### COVID-19 SYMPTOMS:

Fever	Headache	Shortness of Breath
Cough	Sore Throat	Muscle Pain or Body Aches
Congestion	Chills	Loss of Taste or Smell

## IF YOU ARE A CLOSE CONTACT OF SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

May continue to attend school while masking for 5 days following the exposure (day of exposure is Day 0).

### SYMPTOMS

NO

Masking is recommended but not required for days 6-10. Continue to monitor for symptoms.

**Close contact** is defined as within 6 feet for 15 consecutive minutes.

YES

Notify the school nurse and your physician. Testing is recommended. Isolate at home for a minimum of 5 days. If no longer having symptoms or symptoms are resolving, return to school and continue to wear a mask through days 6-10.

## IF YOU LIVE WITH SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

The student can separate from the COVID positive person:

The student remains in close contact with the COVID positive person:

Continue to attend school while wearing a mask for 5 days following last exposure (day 0).

Quarantine for 10 days (your 5 days begins after your household member's 5 day isolation ends). Return to school on day 11 and wear a mask at school for 5 days upon return.

### SYMPTOMS

NO

Masking is recommended but not required for days 6-10. Continue to monitor for symptoms.

YES

Notify the school nurse and your physician. Testing is recommended. Isolate at home for a minimum of 5 days. If no longer having symptoms or symptoms are resolving, return to school and continue to wear a mask through days 6-10.
