

COVID 19 Protocols

*Please note that these protocols are subject to change as the spread develops.

Mitigation Strategies

- Temperature checks are required to enter
- Masks are required on the school buses, per government mandate
- Disinfection/Sanitation procedures will continue
- 3 ft social distancing (*Exception: adult-to-adult and student-to-adult is 6ft*)

Masks

-Masks are optional, but encouraged, at this time. (*Exception: Any student who enters the building with a temperature or shows symptoms during the school day will be required to mask and report to a designated quarantine area.*)

Contact Tracing

-Contact tracing will occur within 3ft for student-to-student and 6ft for student-to-adult and adult-to-adult for contact over 15 consecutive minutes.

Note: If a close contact is vaccinated, the vaccinated individual must mask for 14 days or provide a negative test after day 3, provide the school with a copy of the vaccination record, and may continue attending school. If the test is positive, isolation must begin immediately, and the school nurse will provide further guidance and return-to-school date.

Quarantine vs. Isolation

Quarantine means you have been exposed and may become positive, while isolation means you have received a positive diagnosis.

-If you are required to quarantine due to close contact with a positive COVID 19 case, your **quarantine period** is 10 days.

-The **isolation period** (meaning you have been diagnosed as positive) is 10 days *and* fever-free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication *and* improvement of symptoms.

School Work during Quarantine

- High School classes will be live-streamed and all work will be posted on Google Classroom.
- Middle School, PE, and OME students will access their work on the Google Classroom.
