Member Schools:

The Mountain League has agreed to the following regarding the most recent update on interscholastic sports.

Until Bill 2787 is passed, the venue limits are 25 indoors and 250 outside.

SPECTATOR RULES:

- Spectators must comply with entering and exiting procedures of the venue.
- Masks must be worn at all times.
- Seating areas will allow for members of the same household to sit together while maintaining social distancing from others in attendance.
- Spectators must self-screen and agree not to attend event, if experiencing a fever above 100.4 and any of the following COVID-19 signs and symptoms:
 - Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat, congestion or runny nose
 - Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
- Spectators at no time are permitted to enter the field of play or bench areas.

SPORT SPECIFIC RULES:

***Volleyball** – No spectators permitted due to 25 person indoor limit

Cross Country, Tennis, and Golf – Both home and visiting spectators are permitted up to the 250 outdoor limit.

***Soccer (all levels) and Football (all levels), including scrimmages** – Only ticketed spectators will be permitted. The number of spectators plus all of those involved (athletes, coaches, officials, band members, cheerleaders and essential personnel) must not exceed 250. The distribution of the tickets to spectators is at the discretion of the home school.

*At the time that more spectators are permitted due to venue design each school will have to set their limits but only ticketed persons will be permitted to attend events with priority given to the parents of the student-athletes and participants.

The Mountain League is committed to the safety of all those involved in High School Athletics and recognizes the importance of participation by all stakeholders - band members, cheerleaders, etc and will ensure that all students will take priority in participation before opening the events to spectators.
